



Senior Rule

While finishing your undergraduate degree, students may choose to take some courses that could apply to a graduate degree here at Michigan Tech rather than to the undergraduate degree. A single course may not apply to both degrees, however.

The completed form is due in the Registrar's office by Wednesday of week 2. Once the Senior Rule form has been approved, the decision is final. Your academic record will be updated to reflect graduate status for the courses designated. Courses updated to graduate status will not be changed back to count toward the undergraduate degree. Courses from past terms are not eligible for reclassification. Students filing Senior Rule status will have two transcripts, one for each level.

Note: Courses taken under Senior Rule are not eligible for undergraduate Federal aid. See Financial Aid at [Enrollment Requirements](#).
