


2025-2026 Verification Worksheet - Independent

Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for verification. Federal student aid regulations mandate the collection of this information. Failure to complete verification will prevent you from receiving financial aid. We are required to send discrepant data to the FAFSA processor for correction.
