Historical Note

The Parade of Nations is an annual multicultural event in Houghton, Michigan, established in 1989 to honor and celebrate the region's diverse cultural heritage. Deeply rooted in the history of Michigan's Copper Country, the parade serves as a platform for recognizing both cultural distinctions and shared human experiences, promoting unity and inclusivity. As the largest multicultural celebration in Michigan's Upper Peninsula, it attracts participants and spectators from across the state and neighboring Wisconsin. The event features a dynamic procession

representing a wide array of national and ethnic identities, followed by a multicultural festival offering international cuisine, performances, and educational exhibits that highlight global traditions. Originally organized through a collaboration between local community members and representatives from Michigan Technological University and Finlandia University, the event is now under the stewardship of Michigan Technological University, continuing its mission of fostering cultural appreciation and strengthening community connections.
