

# **Suggested Packing List**

Items listed are general packing guidelines. Please be sure to check our website **mtu.edu/syp/plan/packing-list** for any program specific requirements and detailed information about medications.

### Recommended Items

- $\hfill\square$  Everyday clothing and underwear for a week
- □ Light jacket
- □ Heavy sweatshirt
- □ Rain jacket or umbrella
- Clothes that can get dirty (jeans, t-shirts, etc.)
- $\Box$  Closed-toe shoes (mandatory for lab classes)
- □ Comfortable/casual shoes
- □ Long pants, long-sleeved shirts (mandatory for lab classes and service learning activities)
- □ Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, etc.)
- □ Slippers
- □ Flip flops/shower shoes
- Prescription medications\* (See website for further details)
- Personal fan (box fan or smaller)
- □ Spending money (recommended \$50-60 per week)

# Do Not Bring

- TVs
- Gaming Consoles
- Refrigerators
- Microwaves/Hot Plates
- Drones/UAVs
- Pocket Knives, weapons of any kind or weapon shaped/themed toys
- Binoculars
